 website is woefully out of date, and we need to do whatever is necessary to get
 the/a new website live, even if not complete.
- O USGS Well-Monitoring Program Gager: no new news. Bucknam: Grandview Estates plans 4 readings and samples in 2022 for 19 wells to include geochemistry, especially radon, and mostly from the Dawson aquifer. He noted that dissolved radon commonly aerates within a household's pressure tank.

• New Business

- o Douglas County Referrals
 - SB2021-057 Sterling Ranch Preliminary Plan 7. A preliminary plan application for 1,596 residential lots, 8 superblock lots, and 85 tracts on 464.91 acres of land within the Sterling Ranch Planned Development. In addition, the Sterling Ranch Community Authority Board is proposing reduced water demand standards. The site is generally located both east and west of Roxborough Park Road, north of the Waterton Road extension, south of the PSCo transmission lines. (01/07/2022; no response)
- o Aquifer-depletion study: S. Boand related that he plans to assemble the USGS

- water-level data to create hydrographs for each well, in conjunction with the top and bottom elevation of each well's respective aquifer, per the state's records.
- Castle Rock development: T. Bernhardt related that many Larkspur-area residents are concerned about the effect that 5800 new homes and concomitant commercial development planned by Castle Rock will have on the area's aquifers.
- M. Collit noted that Sedalia would soon be holding a public meeting of residents to discuss the ~\$7M cost and financing to replace the village's old and leaky water mains that serve about 93 customers.





- USGS Well-Monitoring Program Gager noted that our current contract with the
 USGS runs through September 2022 but includes only a February measurement,
 which has been done. His last email to the USGS indicated that currently the
 RWA could only offer matching funds of about \$4500 for a Sept/Oct reading.
 He's received no response to date.

- Districts 1, 3 & 4 Earlier today Mary Lynch resigned as District 1 Director. Director Bernhardt suggested that we might find potential directors amongst those homeowners that are participating in the USGS monitoring program.
- Renewable Energy Credits Director Bucknam has a recent email from the
 Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System (WREGIS) that he
 needs to review.
- Steve Boand: Hydrographs project Mr. Boand presented a preliminary draft hydrograph/wellbore/aquifer display for 4 wells with "continuous" data in the USGS well-monitoring program, and solicited comments and suggestions. Each

display includes a well/aquifer-data box, a wellbore- & aquifer-depth schematic showing the measured "depth to groundwater range", and the plotted hydrograph data for both the past 2 years and the whole project duration. Director Gager noted that the only Denver well had the most-serious decline (but still only about 1ft/year), and that the base of each producing aquifer was still a considerable depth below the current pumping-depth-to-groundwater.



We are coming up on the annual fundraising season, for which the RWF (&RWA) plans to again contact their/our respective lists to solicit donations, some of which may be matched, but not likely to the extent of the last two years. It appears that we do not qualify for the Colorado Gives database. A discussion ensued about how to broaden our reach, perhaps by contacting local/Colorado businesses and/or county well-owners. Delaney indicated that he would write a letter for this audience if Gager would provide the reason they should donate.

The RWA website desperately needs to be replaced and updated. Gager moved to ask Circuit Rider to get access to and review the unfinished website that Kennedy has created, and propose either to use that for our new site, or to create a new site from scratch, like they did for the RWF.
